Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 Red Deer Village Caravan Site, 1 Village Drive, Clayhouse Road, Stepps G33 3AF formerly trading as Craigendmuir Residential Park Homes & Chalet Park, Stepps G33 6AF Amendment to Licence Conditions

I refer to your request regarding alteration to site licence condition 44 relating to Red Deer Village.

I would advise that the practical impact of the changes to the licensing regime implemented under the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960, as brought about by the Fire (Scotland) Act 2005 is that local authorities can no longer impose conditions relating solely to fire safety in caravan site licences for sites deemed to be relevant premises under the Fire (Scotland) Act 2005. Such matters fall within the enforcement jurisdiction of the fire service. Conditions which relate to privacy and/or amenity, as well as fire safety, will remain in force e.g. space separation between caravans.

As such condition 44 will be amended to

'At least 2.75 square metres of covered storage area should be provided for each caravan standing. The structures should be capable of being locked.

Such storage provision will not be required where the occupant has made other appropriate storage arrangements which comply with this requirement.'

A copy of the site licence and the conditions attached to it are required to be displayed prominently
